1. How long does the visa process take? Is it possible to complete it in two months, or will it remain in process until next year? This depends on the student case and the issuing authority (roughly two weeks). We issue the letter once the student is admitted.

2. Does the institution provide its own accommodation? If so, is it available for both single and married individuals?

3. How many days a week does a student have to attend when doing the PhD/MA program? None. There are no classes, students liaise directly with their supervisor, this can all be done virtually.

4. Which fields of study are available? Departments | University of Pretoria (up.ac.za)

5. What documents are required? For an application you require a passport, full official academic records, a saqa certificate or at least the application with SAQA. Admission will only be finalised when the certificate is obtained.

6. Postdoctoral Research
